

## *Jewish Sanitarium Calls Fund Meeting*

A meeting of the board of directors and representatives of 5,000 members of the Jewish Sanitarium for Incurables has been called for Tuesday evening at the institution, Rutland rd. and East 49th st.

Ways and means of raising funds to wipe out last year's deficit and to secure hospital beds and equipment for completion of four new wards by Jan. 1, will be the principal topic of the meeting.

Completely modern in every detail, the new pavilion of the sanitarium has been outfitted up to the fourth floor. When funds are available the top two floors will be thrown open. Included in the plans are opening of a complete operating room stadium and a series of X-ray rooms.

At present there are 468 patients in both buildings of the institution. When fully in service the hospital will care for more than 600 men, women and children.

The synagogue in the pavilion, seating more than 500, will be open to the general public for the Rosh Hashonah and Yom Kippur services, beginning next week.
