

J. C. Albert, Father Of Hospital Head

Joseph C. Albert, 90, father of Isaac Albert, president of the Jewish Chronic Disease Hospital of Brooklyn, died Sunday at the hospital. He lived at 935 Eastern Parkway.

The Joseph Chaim Albert Temple at the hospital was named in his honor for the work he had done in behalf of the hospital. He was born in Sloim, Russia, came here when he was 27 and for many years was engaged in the manufacture of lighting fixtures.
