



**RENAMED PRESIDENT FOR 18TH TERM:—**Isaac Albert, who has served as president of the Jewish Chronic Disease Hospital, E. 49 St. & Rutland Rd., Bklyn, N.Y., since 1943, was unanimously reelected for his eighteenth consecutive term.
