The Bar Mitzvah of Philip Levine, 13, a patient at the Jewish Sanitarium and Hospital for Chronic Diseases took place Saturday morning, 9:00 a.m. May 29 in the hospital's Joseph Chaim Albert Temple, East 49 Street and Rutland Road, Brooklyn.

The sanitarium is the beneficiary of funds raised by the Harriette Beverly Men's League.

Philip who has been afflicted with muscular dystrophy since the age of three was admitted to the hospital in 1951.

A handsome youngster whose dark features and rugged appearance belie his physical disability, Philip has participated in many of the activities of the youngsters at the hospital.

In addition to receiving his grammar school education at the hospital's P. S. 401, he has been a member of the institution's cub scout troop \$257 for the past two years.
