

### JEWISH SANITARIUM FOR INCURABLES TO DINE GOOD FRIENDS

Max Blumberg, president of the Jewish sanitarium for incurables, will underwrite a dinner tendered by the executive committee of the \$10,000 drive to the many friends and workers of the campaign. This dinner will take place on Wednesday, October 27, 1926, at 8.30 p. m., at the Brooklyn Jewish Center, 687 Eastern parkway, Brooklyn. Nathan D. Shapiro, who is actively participating in this \$100,000 drive, will preside as chairman of the dinner committee.

This dinner will be visited by notables of Brooklyn, business men as well as professional.

Despite the highly developed system of Jewish charitable activities in Brooklyn there is one branch of its activities which has been neglected and that is the erection of a home and hospital for Jewish paralyzed and crippled incurables, which will be the first of its kind ever to be built by Jews of the borough and will be erected at East 49th street and Buitland road, East Flatbush, Brooklyn.

At the above dinner, which will constitute a gathering of men and women who are sympathizing with the most unfortunate situation of the homeless and helpless Jewish incurables, will prove to be an event of outstanding importance in social activities of the borough because the result of this gathering will secure the erection of a new, useful and necessary Jewish institution of our borough.
