

RUSH SYNAGOGUE WORK

Hope Is to Have Edifice Ready for
Jewish Holy Days.

Contractors, working day and night, are rushing construction on the interior synagogue of the Jewish Sanitarium for Incurables, to finish in time for use during the Jewish holy days. The new hospital building of the Jewish Sanitarium, located at Rutland rd. and East 49th st., will be completed within five weeks.

Prayer services in the synagogue will be held on Rosh Hashonah, September 15 and 16, and Yom Kipur, September 24. Cantor Solomon Seligman has been chosen to conduct the services.

The synagogue is designed as part of the hospital for prayer and meditation by the 300 hopelessly crippled and diseased to be housed there. A number of civic and philanthropic organizations have already signified their intention of affiliating with the synagogue.

Prayer services have been arranged by a special committee of the Jewish Sanitarium, headed by Max Blumberg, president.
